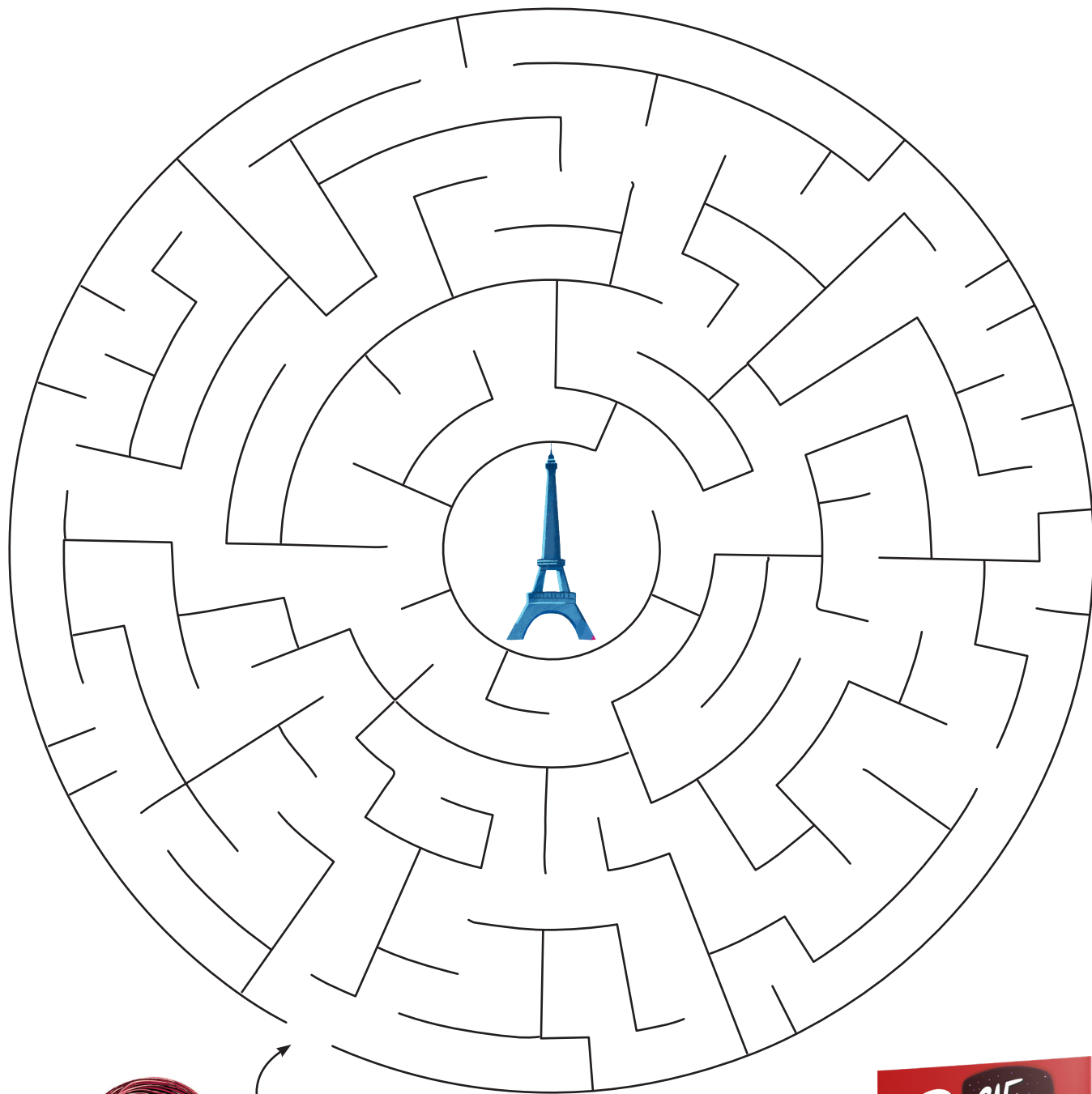

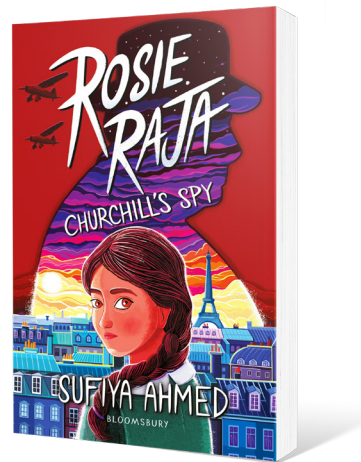


# ESCAPE THE MAZE

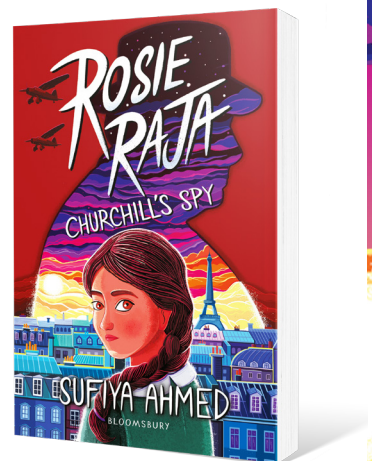

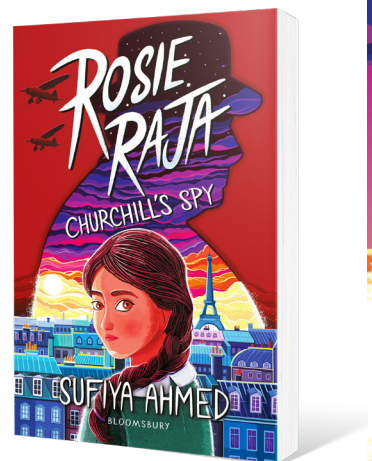

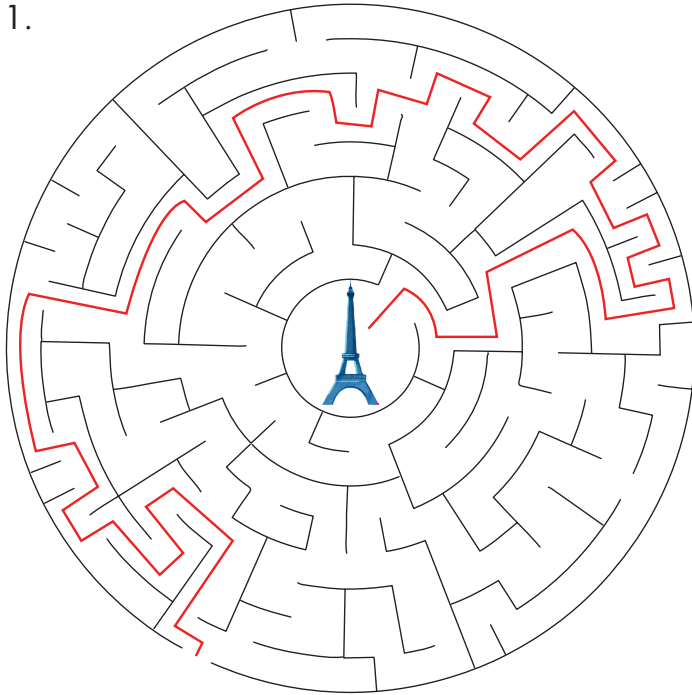
